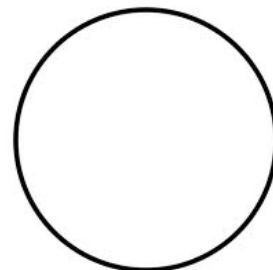
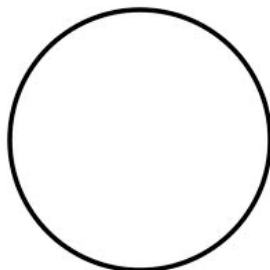
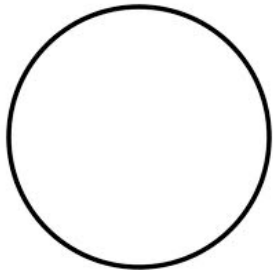

24 He himself carried our sins in his body on the cross. He did it so that we would die as far as sins are concerned. Then we would lead godly lives. His wounds have made you whole.

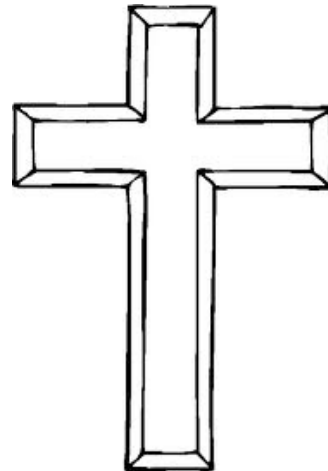




Repent means to turn from disobeying God (sin) to obeying Him. It means to be sorry for our sin and to live the way God wants us to live.

Jesus died on the cross to forgive our sins. He paid the consequence for our sin, that is His gift to us. Write down a sin you've done on the cross.
